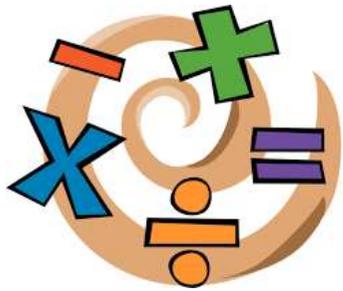
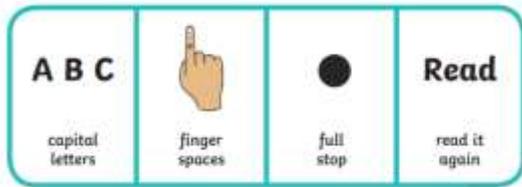

## Year 2 Homework Autumn Term

<p><b>English:</b></p> <p>Write 3 sentences about what you did during the summer holidays.</p> <p>Remember to use capital letters and full stops.</p>	<p><b>English:</b></p> <p>Write 3-5 sentences about your favourite hobby and use conjunctions to add more detail.</p> <p>(and, but, so, because, if, or, when, that)</p>	<p><b>English:</b></p> <p>Write a postcard about a holiday- use an expanded noun phrase to describe what you could see.</p>
<p><b>Maths:</b></p> <p>Use a random number generator to gather 2-digit numbers.</p> <p>Can you partition these into tens and ones? Can you partition into different combinations? e.g. <math>42 = 40 + 2</math>, <math>30 + 12</math>, <math>20 + 22</math>, <math>10 + 32</math></p>	<p><b>Maths:</b></p> <p>Practise the number bonds to 10 and use these to support understanding of number bonds to 20.</p>	<p><b>Maths:</b></p> <p>Add 2 2-digit numbers together that don't involve regrouping</p> <p>e.g. <math>23 + 14 =</math></p> <p>Then try to add 2 2-digit numbers that do require regrouping</p> <p>e.g. <math>34 + 27 =</math></p>
<p><b>Science:</b></p> <p>Create a list of animals and their babies. Why do animals have offspring?</p>	<p><b>Science:</b></p> <p>Compare a photo as you as a baby and as you are now. What do you notice? What is the same and what is different? Share this with the class.</p>	<p><b>Science:</b></p> <p>Write a food diary. Did you eat your five a day, every day?</p>
<p><b>Art:</b></p> <p>Draw a portrait of Queen Victoria. What media will you use?</p>	<p><b>History:</b></p> <p>Research a Victorian toy. Discuss with your grown ups what toys they had when they were younger.</p>	<p><b>PSHE:</b></p> <p>Play a board game with your family. Take turns, share and listen to others. How did you feel while playing?</p>
