Repeat the process to create 5 calculations.</p>	<p>Maths:</p> <p>Using 6-sided dice to create 1 2-digit or a 3-digit number between 20 - 120 Use the expanded column method to divide this number by 3, 4, 6 or 8. Repeat the process to create 5 calculations.</p>
