### Year 1 Phonics Screening Check



#### What is phonics?

- Children have 25 mins daily discrete phonics lessons.
- Children are taught to read by breaking down words into separate sounds or 'phonemes' (segmenting). They are then taught how to blend these sounds together to read the whole word (blending).
- There are around 40 different sounds.







#### What is the check for?

The check is to assess your child's phonic knowledge.
This will help us to know how best to teach and support your child with their reading.



#### When will the check take place?

The check will happen in school at the beginning of June.



#### What will the check consist of?

- 40 words for your child to read.
- Half the words will be real words.
- Half the words will be nonsense words.




#### What will the children do?

-The check will take around 10 minutes.

-They will be asked to read a word and blend the sounds together. e.g.  $d\mbox{-}\sigma\mbox{-}g$  – dog.

-Children will be told if the word is a real or nonsense, with a corresponding alien image.







#### How can you help?

Encourage them to use their sounds and actions

to find the sound they need.

Children can practise their phonics by playing

games online. Many games check real and

nonsense words.







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#### How can you help?

REMEMBER: Phonics is not the only way you become a good reader.

-Continue to read with your child

- -Sound out, re-read to check it makes sense.
- -Ask questions about the book;
- -And most importantly ENJOY READING!







#### What is the pass mark?

The pass mark is subject to change. However, over the last 2-3 years the pass mark has been 32/40.





# What happens if my child doesn't pass?

If your child does not pass the Phonics Screening check this year, they will re-take the screener the following year (when they are in Year 2) with the next Year 1 cohort. They will continue to be supported with their Phonics in Year 2.
