Your child's token will be handed to them in class on the day and can be redeemed at most UK bookshops.

Schools and libraries across the UK celebrate World Book Day with a huge range of events and activities. Here is what we will be doing on World Book Day and how you can help your children be involved:

### **Dress as your favourite book character**
